“We’re from the Government...” How to Prepare for a Government Investigation

Join the NVTC General Counsel Committee for an executive briefing on how to get your company ready for the prospect of a government investigation, including steps to lower your exposure. State and federal authorities are increasingly training their civil and criminal investigative powers on businesses, large and small. - Essential steps in-house counsel should be prepared to carry out within 24 hours of being served with a search warrant, a criminal subpoena, a civil subpoena or a civil investigative demand.
- The key things you should - and should not - do when you learn that the government has begun questioning employees, customers, etc.
- Hot investigative topics for state attorneys general, including deceptive/unfair trade practices; and privacy/security breaches, including identity theft.
- Areas of heightened recent interest to federal investigators, including the False Claims Act, Dodd-Frank Whistleblower actions; and enforcement of the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act.
- Areas where both state and federal authorities are flexing their powers, including corporate espionage, theft of trade secrets, antitrust and financial fraud.
